

NOTICE TO ALL GREYHOUND OWNERS

INSPECTION OF GREYHOUNDS AFTER NAMING

Congratulations on receiving your Certificate of Registration for your Greyhound, to enable your Greyhound to commence its racing career you are required to have your Greyhound undergo an Official inspection by a GRNSW Steward/Official prior to being eligible to:-

- Nominate for a Race Meeting
 - Enter into Breeding Activities
 - Be sold, Transferred or Leased
1. Present the Greyhound for issue of a weight card at any of the scheduled inspection times.
 2. Provided that the marking official is satisfied that the Greyhound presented matches the markings and ear brands on the Certificate of Registration. The official will date and stamp the Certificate of Registration and hand the Certificate of Registration with the new weight card to the owner or trainer.
 3. Upon receiving a signed Certificate of Registration and weight card, the Greyhound may be nominated for an event.
 4. In order to compete in a maiden event at a TAB Meeting a Greyhound must have performed satisfactorily in a Performance Qualifying Trial. Weight Cards may be issued prior to these Performance Qualifying Trials as directed on this schedule.
 5. Should the marking official deem that the Certificate of Registration requires adjustment, and then the official shall adjust the Certificate and stamp the card.

To assist, you will find on the reverse side of this page a detailed listing of GRNSW's Identification Schedule, which will aid in you in making arrangements for your Greyhound to be inspected.

Please ensure that the Greyhound's **Certificate of Registration** is readily available on inspection. Without the **Certificate of Registration**, the Greyhound will be deemed ineligible for inspection and a Weight Card will **not** be issued.

PLEASE NOTE:-

Failure to adhere to this request will result in the Greyhound being ineligible to be nominated and/or compete. Consequently, we seek all Owner/Trainers co-operation with this procedure.
