Trainer Trent Anderson highlighted the greyhound's relative inexperience and explained that he has been unable to field trial leading into tonight's race.	
4 One More Beer	Turned its head in slightly over the concluding stages when reaching the lead. After viewing all available footage including the head-on and after taking into account the submissions tendered by trainer Gary Stewart, the minor nature of the incident and the winning margin of the greyhound, Stewards were comfortably satisfied that a breach under the rules did not occur, however, advised Mr. Stewart that its future performances would be closely monitored.
