The trainer did not arrive the necessary 30 minutes before kennelling to allow time for these checks to be completed and therefore the trial could not be run. Stewards contacted the Stewarding team and the on track veterinary surgeon for tomorrow's meeting and arranged for the trial to be completed tomorrow

1 Surfer Boy	Moved out turning into the home straight coming together with another runner becoming unbalanced and losing momentum and then came together with another runner again shortly afterwards losing further momentum before being galloped on by the other runner and stumbling mildly. A post race veterinary examination was carried out revealing soreness to the right groin- a 10 day incapacitation period was issued
4 Go Forward Cathy	Was found to be limping in the catching pen. A post race veterinary examination was carried out revealing soreness to the right shoulder - a 7 day incapacitation period was issued
6 Rob You Blind	Started as a well supported favourite but found interference passing the catching pen and again in the early stages of the turn from the back straight losing momentum on both occasions

1 Mighty Dukey	Came together midway through the turn to the back straight losing momentum
2 Gundangara Boy	Came together midway through the turn to the back straight losing momentum
4 Geordie	Came together midway through the turn to the back straight losing momentum
5 Luke No Figure	Came together midway through the turn to the back straight and fell. A post race veterinary examination was carried out revealing fractures to the right Radius and Ulna - a 90 day incapacitation period was issued and the greyhound was transported to the designated off track veterinary practise for immediate assessment
6 Jilliby Jewel	Came together midway through the turn to the back straight and fell. Completed the course some distance behind the rest of the field. A post race veterinary examination was carried out revealing soreness to the Right Hock - a 14 day incapacitation period was issued
8 Vanity Gold	A pre race urine sample was collected. Came together midway through the turn to the back straight checking severely off other falling runners and stumbling heavily. Completed the course some distance behind the rest of the field. A post race veterinary examination was carried out revealing no apparent injury

A number of trainers raised concerns with Stewards post race regarding the manner the handler of #2 GOING BUSH boxed his dog and his apparent delay in doing so. Stewards reviewed the race footage and noted that the handler of #6 PLAY DUMB boxed his greyhound in a similar manner. After considering the matter and speaking to the handler of #6 Stewards were of the opinion that whilst the boxing was somewhat unorthodox it did not breach any rules and did not cause undue delay.

4 Lady Luella

Began as the favourite. Came together in the early stages of the first turn losing momentum and then coming together with other runners becoming unbalanced and losing further momentum.

A post race veterinary examination was carried out revealing soreness to the Right Hock - a 14 day incapacitation period was issued
