Stewards spoke to trainer Mrs. Barbera Beach regarding the poor performance of the greyhound after being heavily favoured in the market. Mrs. Beach stated the greyhound hasn't competed for 5 months after its first race but had been trialing well lately. Mrs. Beach further stated that she was very surprised by the market support and the kennel had only moderately supported the greyhound. Mrs. Beach also added she had been disappointed with its performance and felt the greyhound needed more experience in field events to mature. A post-race urine sample was obtained.
