Mr O'Brien stated the greyhound, which was only having its second race start made the boxing procedure awkward when he noticed the greyhound had sat down and was displaying its tail out the back of the boxes once the roller door was shut. Stewards acknowledged this, however, reminded Mr O'Brien of his obligations that once placing a greyhound in the starting boxes, you cannot correct the position of the greyhound in accordance with GAR105(10)(d). No further action was taken. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent injury after beginning awkwardly and was slow to begin before making contact with the running rail making the first turn.
