2 Clover Ken	<p>Checked off the rear of another runner when challenging for the lead after leaving the first turn, before dropping back through the field sharply and colliding with numerous other runners.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination revealed a spike wound to the offside hindfoot. No stand down period was issued.</p>
3 Last Laugh	<p>Severely inconvenienced by other runners when leaving the first turn and became unbalanced, losing substantial ground.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination detected no apparent anomalies.</p>
5 Wilgunya Mel	<p>Collided with other runners that were inconvenienced after leaving the first turn, then fell.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination detected no apparent anomalies.</p>
6 Margie Bourbon	<p>Heels were contacted by another runner when in the leading group after leaving the first turn, then became unbalanced and collided with numerous other greyhounds before falling.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination detected no apparent anomalies.</p>

Shifted in and contacted the heels of that runner when entering the turn into the front section of the track, before colliding with other runners that were trailing, becoming unbalanced and losing substantial ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an injury to the nearside pin muscle and abrasions to both hindlegs and was stood down for a period of 14 days.

1 Who Roux Dude	A pre-race urine sample was obtained.
7 Sandave Tommy	<p>A post-race urine sample was obtained.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to trainer Mrs. Sandra Richardson regarding a substantial betting move attributed to the greyhound with coincided with a personal best time over the track and distance. Mrs. Richardson stated the greyhound had only recently returned to their kennels and had been given a freshen up to overcome some issues that had been identified. Mrs. Richardson further stated that the greyhound had relished being back in its home environment and had been trialling well at the track before todays event. Mrs. Richardson also stated that this was the first greyhound to compete under her name as a recently accredited trainer and this may have contributed to the good performance.</p>
8 Michelle Bourbon	<p>Marginally slow to begin. Checked and lost ground when entering the first turn. Wasn't competitive thereafter.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination detected no apparent anomalies. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. Christopher Supple regarding the poor performance of his greyhound in todays event. Mr. Supple stated that the greyhound is better suited to the inside boxes and generally needs to lead, or be near it, to perform best. Mr. Supple further stated that the quick early tempo coupled with the uncharacteristic slower beginning, had hindered the greyhounds performance.</p>
